What to Expect at Sac High for 2018-2019

In last few months, SHPS school leaders have been studying, researching and visiting the top charter networks around the country. What we learned was that Sac High was one of the largest urban comprehensive charter high schools in the country and that few others had tried to do what we were doing. Most of the top schools had about half the student population of Sac High, and while some had sustained leadership longer, they did not offer options for students to compete in activities like athletics. This fall, we will embark on our next evolution. The network will begin a transformation that we believe will help us reach our long-term vision of being one of the top urban TK-12 charter networks in the country.

While we want to maintain our status as a comprehensive high school, we know that it has been challenging to find and retain one leader to operate the entire school. In an effort to attack these issues, next year Sac High will provide 9th Grade Academy for all incoming freshman. The Academy will be run by a team that is specifically focused on ensuring 9th graders start their high school experience off on the right foot. We also have developed a new leadership structure for 10-12 grades to ensure that both students and staff have the support and accountability needed to be successful.

What is 9th Grade Academy?

At the start of the 2018-19 school year, all incoming 9th grade scholars at Sacramento Charter High School will enter into the 9th Grade Academy. The 9th Grade Academy is a rigorous college-preparatory program intended to support our scholars in their transition from middle school to high school.

What will it look like to be a scholar in the 9th grade academy?

In the 9th Grade Academy, scholars will take all necessary A-G requirements for freshman scholars including Geometry or Algebra, English Language Arts, Biology, History, Art and Physical Education. In addition to these core classes, your scholar will participate in an Advisory program and will have access to tutoring three days a week. All scholars will have the opportunity to participate in the school-wide events as well as additional activities that will be planned to help develop a positive culture for our 9th graders.
